But, nevertheless, the horrible weather didn’t destroy the good mood we had and, of course, the sun glasses remained on our noses.

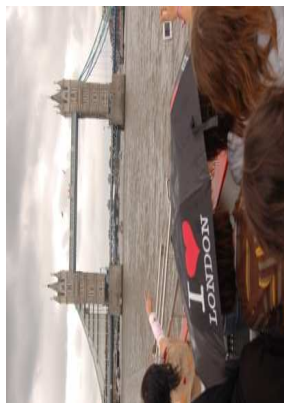
True London tourists are prepared for everything and so we kept smiling.
